

**Deer resistant,
low maintenance**

Scientific Name: *Aesculus parviflora*

Common Name: Bottlebrush Buckeye

Hardiness Zones: 4-8

Habit: 8-12 feet tall by 8-15 feet wide

Growth Rate: Slow

Form: Wide spreading suckering and multi-stemmed shrub

Foliage: Deciduous, 3-8 inches long, palmately compound (5-7 leaflets), opposite, medium to dark green leaves in summer with good yellow fall color

Aesculus parviflora Bottlebrush Buckeye

Flowers: long spikes of white flowers in June – July with long stamens and pistils imparting a bottlebrush appearance

Site Requirements: Prefers full sun to partial shade and moist soil

Description: An outstanding large shrub with few rivals in the urban landscape
