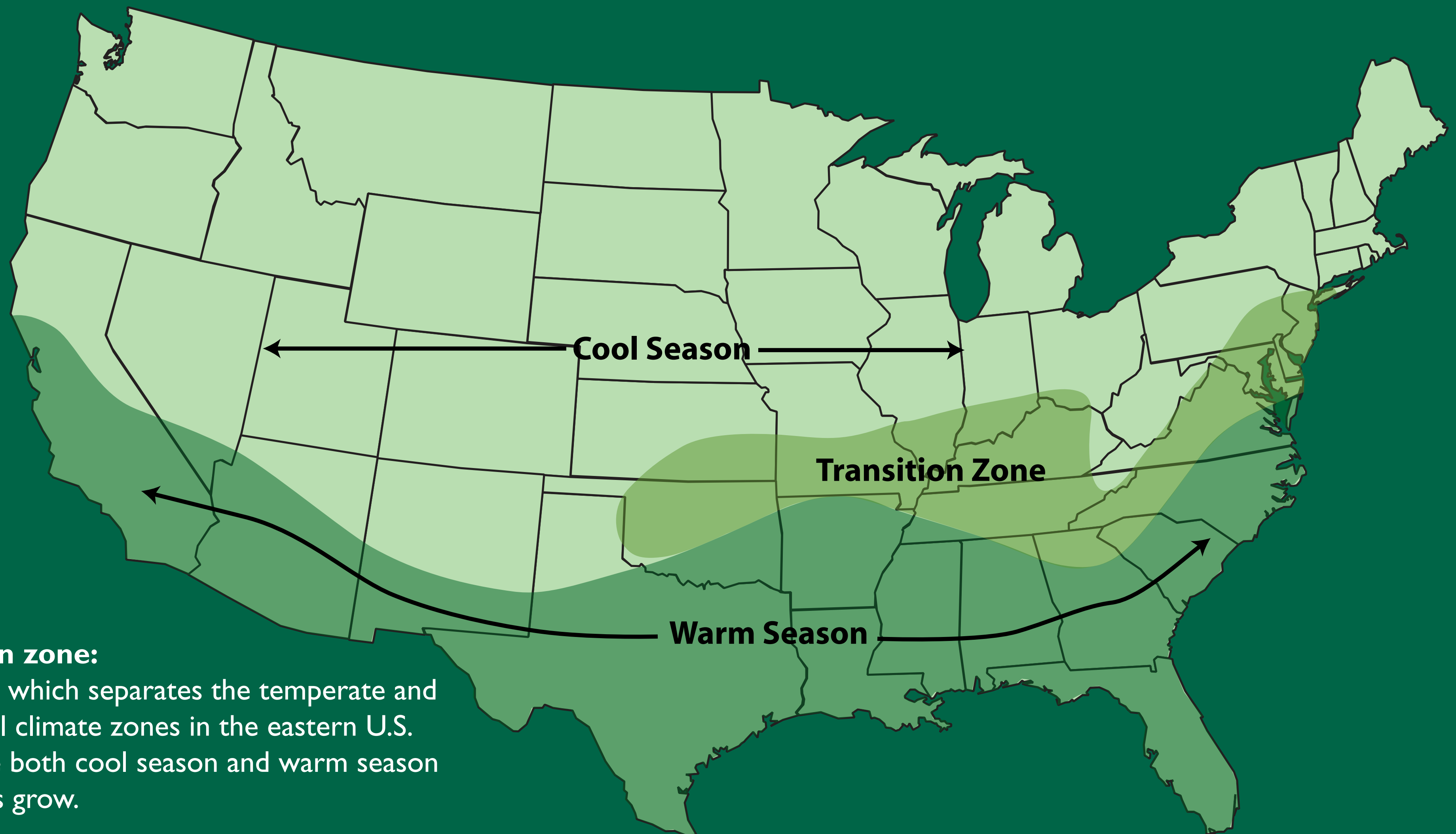


# Know Your Turf



## Transition zone:

Is the area which separates the temperate and subtropical climate zones in the eastern U.S. and where both cool season and warm season turfgrasses grow.

## Do you know your turf?

### Cool-Season Turf:

(Turf-type tall fescue, Kentucky bluegrass, Perennial ryegrass, Fine fescues)

- Seed primarily in the fall
- Fertilize primarily in the fall
- Mow at 3 inches
- Allow grass to go dormant in summer; watering when needed

### Warm-Season Turf:

(Zoysiagrass, Bermudagrass)

- Seed/sod/plug during the warm season
- Fertilize during the summer
- Mow at 3 inches (home lawns)
- Allow grass to go dormant in summer; watering when needed
